WILLOWS ON THE RIVULET

Following serious erosion on the *Hobart Rivulet* outside the Matron's Cottage at the *Cascades Female Factory Historic Site* in May, it is, perhaps, timely to reproduce correspondence received by ASHN many moons ago, after another serious flood on the *Hobart Rivulet*. The recent erosion follows the removal of a massive willow stump, which acted to maintain the integrity of the river bank. A similar removal of a willow stump opposite the Tannery in the 1990s resulted in similar massive erosion of the *Hobart Rivulet Linear Park*, which reduced the track's width appreciably. The previous writer, a respected employee of Parks & Wildlife, wrote: "*I have some real concern regarding the notes on Crack Willow (Salix fragilis) that appeared in an edition of 'Capital City News'. Whilst I acknowledge that Crack Willow can cause some problems, in that it is liable to proliferate and to shed branches, I believe that its virtues far outweigh those features. As you acknowledge, it prevents erosion and is a pleasant feature of the riverscape. Erosion is a matter of*

serious concern and, now that the willow is established, it is almost impossible to replace it and, at the same time, avoid accelerated erosion. The developments at Vauchuse, on the Hobart Rivulet, illustrate this vividly, and the campaign against Crack Willow on the banks of the Jordan River, west of Bridgewater, have lead to gross bank deterioration. I believe that these are cases of 'Selective Botanical Nationalism' gone mad. The reality is that not only is the Crack Willow an asset, albeit somewhat awkward, but it is a part of the European settlement history of Tasmania - more of an asset than a liability." October's Silver Screen is "Wildness". Olegas Truchanas and Peter Dombrovskis were, perhaps, Australia's greatest wilderness photographers. Their work became synonymous with campaigns to protect Tasmania's natural heritage. They shared many things, including a bond that was more like that of father and son. Both came Baltic Europe and migrated to Tasmania, where their passion for nature became a crusade to save an environment under threat. Both died in the wilderness, doing what they loved, and left a legacy in extraordinary images. Their philosophy was simple and remarkably effective - if people could see the beauty of Australia's wild places then they might be moved to save them.
