CABLE CAR BASE STATION TRAFFIC

The *Mount Wellington Cableway Company* (MWCC) continues to claim that traffic to its base station - wherever that may be - will have minimal impact on the amenity of South Hobartians. Many residents are sceptical of this claim. As part of a development application to the *City of Hobart* to build a cable car, a traffic impact statement (TIA) is required by the MWCC. The Association has asked the *City of Hobart* to ensure a thorough **Public Consultation Report** be part of this TIA. In the meantime, all residents of South Hobart, and especially those living on Cascade Road, are invited to collect evidence of current traffic movements, and evidence of existing increasing tourist traffic and the effects it is having on our Suburb. Evidence can be in the form of written reports, but,

preferably, photographic. All evidence will be collated by this Association at a later date. Most residents will now be aware of the delays for South Hobartians trying to leave the suburb by either Davey or Macquarie Streets. This is the consequence of the State Government's alterations to the traffic signalling on the Davey/Macquarie Street 'couplet'. Queues now form back as far as a D'Arcy Street on Macquarie Street and up above "Ashleigh" on Davey Street [above Elboden Street].

HOBART WOMAN DIES IN 110th YEAR

HOBART, Wednesday.—The last Hobart woman centenarian, Mrs. Mary Anne Crowe, who was reputed to be the oldest living woman in Australia, died at Hobart yesterday. She was in her 110th year.
Mrs. Crowe was the third of Hobart's women centenarians to die during July. Mrs. Mary Anne Elizabeth Blukney, aged 101, died at North Hobart on July 3, and Mrs. Mary Rex, also aged 101 years, died on the following day at Bellerside.
Mrs. Crowe was born at Walthamstow, Essex, England. She came to Tasmania in the vessel Pathuan about 60 years ago with her husband, Mr. Peter Crowe, who took up dairying at South Hobart. For many years she lived at the Cascade home of her son, Mr. Peter Crowe.
Four of her 11 children are living—Messrs. Peter Crowe and George Crowe and Mesdames P. Blake and D. J. Haywood, all of Hobart. Mrs. Crowe's husband died in 1907, aged 69 years.
Until a few weeks ago Mrs. Crowe regularly visited the homes of her surviving children. She was remarkably alert, retaining her health and faculties until the end. She leaves 28 grandchildren, 35 great-grandchildren and four great-great-grandchildren.

HORSES ON SOUTH HOBART RECREATION GROUND

How times change.

At a time when there is public debate concerning dog walking on the *South Hobart Recreation Ground*, it is interesting to note that, in 1916, *Hobart City Council* approved Mr. C. Kennedy grazing horses on the Grounds between the hours of 8:00pm and 6:00am in the Summer months, and between 5:00pm and 8:00am in the Winter months. Also, one cow would be allowed to graze during the day, except on Saturday. There was no mention of the need to remove any 'residues', although the Ground was

ARE YOU NEXT?

Residents in Anglesea and Adelaide Streets have recently been made

aware of the repercussions the new State-wide Planning Legislation can have on one's property. Under this new draconian and undemocratic legislation, property owners can find that, under the Hobart Interim Planning Scheme, 2015 and within the Inner Residential Zone, Council has been required to approve such a development without scope for third party right of representation nor appeal. In other words, a development now can be approved without your knowledge. There will also be no Council Development Application notification attached to the proposed development site.

HELPING NATIVE AUSTRALIAN BEES

Bees need flowers, so one of the simplest things you can do to help our native bees is to plant as many flowers as you can. Aim for a mix of species, with something in bloom at all times of the year. Some native bees feed primarily on native plants, while others are less picky. Native plant species such as callistemon, brachyscome and melaleuca are good choices, as are non-natives like perennial basil, salvias and lavenders. Many bees and flies love brassicas (broccoli, kale, mustard), so allowing a few plants to go to flower will delight your buzzy friends! And don't worry if you live in a highly urbanised concrete jungle. Research has found that even inner-city gardens can support a large number of bees as long as there are plenty of flowers. If you plant it, they will come. In fact, some research suggests that cities may be important sites for bee conservation due to their lower insecticide uses and high numbers of flowers in places like private and community gardens.
