The Prime Minister has referred your letter of today's date to me as it relates to the ALP campaign in Denison rather than to a matter of government.

There is nothing defamatory or misleading in the ALP advertising you complain about.

This election is about plans for the future and the choice people will make on September 7. In Denison we believe voters are faced with a simple choice between re-electing you or electing Labor's candidate Jane Austin.

You have ruled out supporting a Labor Government. If Jane Austin is elected, this is one more MP supporting a Labor Government. If you are re-elected, there will be one less MP who supports a Labor Government.


