I am pleased that the Premier and I have been able to clear the air between us in a constructive way. I can only hope my Office and I can return to focus on the serious matters of murder, rape, robbery, major theft and the like which are far more pressing and important than “constitutional crises” which never were.

Calls for some “review” of a particular case are quite misconceived. I have great faith in the established system of justice in this State and will not agree to the elitist suggestion that there should be, in effect, one set of laws and rules for the powerful or well-connected who are able to enlist media and political support and another for everyone else.
