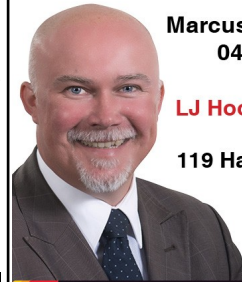
CASCADES FEMALE FACTORY HISTORIC SITE
