GENERAL PURPORT OR EFFECT OF THE ABOVEMENTIONED STATUTORY RULES

(1) Proclamation under section 2 of the *Fluoridation Amendment Act 2009*

This proclamation fixes 1 October 2009 as the day on which the *Fluoridation Amendment Act 2009* commences.

(2) *National Parks and Reserves Management (Rosny Hill Nature Recreation Area - Managing Authority) Order 2009*

This order declares Clarence City Council to be the managing authority for the Rosny Hill Nature Recreation Area.

(3) *Pharmacists Registration (Fees) Amendment Regulations 2009*

These regulations amend the *Pharmacists Registration (Fees) Regulations 2003* by increasing the annual registration fee payable under the *Pharmacists Registration Act 2001*.

(4) *Water and Sewerage Industry (Community Service Obligation) Regulations 2009*

These regulations prescribe who is eligible for a concession under the *Water and Sewerage Industry (Community Service Obligation) Act 2009*, the base amount for calculation of the concession, the percentage amount by which that base amount is to be increased for a financial year and the prescribed institutions for the purposes of the Act.

(5) *Youth Justice Regulations 2009*

These regulations—

- (a) prescribe persons who may make certain applications under sections 55, 56, 68 and 94 of the *Youth Justice Act 1997*; and
- (b) provide the procedure for appeals under section 118 of that Act; and
- (c) are made consequentially on the repeal of the *Youth Justice Regulations 1999* under section 11 of the *Subordinate Legislation Act 1992*.
