AN OPEN LETTER TO ALL MEMBERS OF THE CURENT AUSTRALIAN FEDERAL GOVERNMENT – CANBERRA

Between now and the first sitting of parliament of 2016 each and every one of the members of both the lower and the upper houses of parliament need to stop and **reflect upon**:

The Fact that if you are not prepared to put aside your own personal agendas or those of your parties, back room factions and vested interest and lobby groups that you subscribe to and instead to **“swear or affirm”** to truly **serve** the people of Australia then the only “honorable” act left for you to do is to resign your elected position and leave parliament forthwith and be-gone with you

The Fact that those members of parliament and senators that do recognize and honor their oath should at the very least recognize and remind those that don't and hold them accountable. To recognize a wrong and yet to acquiesce to that wrong is paramount to perpetrating that wrong oneself
