### Other measures of poverty

- 16,038 families with children (under 16) living on less than \$37,378 per year in Tasmania (the indexed-to-2016 Henderson poverty line for a single parent family with two children (PHIDU).
- 21,500 Tasmanian households (10.2%) could not pay an electricity, gas, or phone bill on time in the past year (2015-16 ABS Household Expenditure Survey). This is higher than the nationwide rate.

### Income scenarios

- A single parent of two children = \$35,041 (not working; the youngest who is 5 or younger and the oldest 12 or younger, not including rent assistance, and max PPS and FTB part A and B).
- A couple with two children = \$41,048 (the youngest 5 or younger and the oldest 12 or younger, both outof-work, one on parenting payment partnered and the other on Newstart, not including rent assistance, max PPP, Newstart, and FTB part A and B).
- A single = \$14,047 (Newstart, not-in-work, not including rent assistance).
