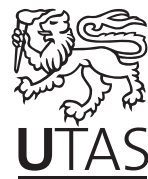
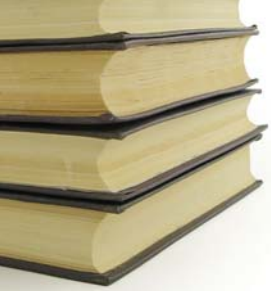

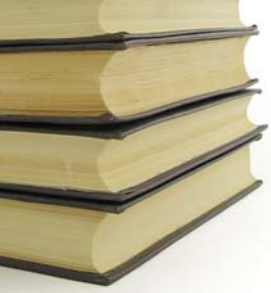

Announcement Events

1. The Prizes will be announced at a function at the Commissariat Store, Tasmanian Museum & Art Gallery, Hobart, on Saturday 4 April 2009.
2. Shortlisted authors and partners will be invited to be guests of Arts Tasmania at the Award announcement function.
3. A series of public lunchtime events featuring shortlisted writers and Award winners will be coordinated under the Ten Days on the Island program, also at the Commissariat Store, from 1 to 4 April, 2009.
4. It is expected that shortlisted authors and publishers will participate in these events.

conditions of entry

The Prizes

Tasmania Book Prize - Best Book with Tasmanian Content in any Genre - \$25,000.

Margaret Scott Prize - Best Book by a Tasmanian Writer - \$5000.

University of Tasmania Prize - Best Book by a Tasmanian Publisher - \$5000.

General Eligibility

1. The nominated book must have been published in English for the first time between 2 July 2006 and 1 July 2008.
2. A book is defined as a paper-based publication that is available for sale.
3. Authors must be living on the date of entry.
4. The decision of Arts Tasmania regarding eligibility is final and no correspondence will be entered into.

Eligibility for the Tasmania Book Prize

5. A book with Tasmanian content may be nominated irrespective of where the author lives or where the publisher is based.
6. A book by a Tasmanian writer or publisher can satisfy the Tasmanian content requirement where the judges recognise the influence Tasmania has had on its content or perspective.
7. Judges will advise Arts Tasmania on content eligibility and the decision of Arts Tasmania is final and no correspondence will be entered into.

Eligibility for the Margaret Scott Prize and University of Tasmania Prize

8. A Tasmanian writer is defined as one who is ordinarily resident in Tasmania.
9. A Tasmanian publisher is defined as one whose publishing business is based in Tasmania.
10. Books by Tasmanian writers and publishers may also be eligible for the Tasmania Book Prize (see Eligibility 6).

Nomination

1. Nominations will only be accepted from publishers.
2. Closing date for nominations is Monday 15 September 2008.
3. Publishers must send a completed nomination form and four copies of each nominated title to Arts Tasmania by the closing date.
4. There is no limit to the number of titles a publisher may submit, but each nomination must be on a separate nomination form.
5. Where a book is eligible for more than one Prize there is no need to submit more than four copies.
6. Entry fee per title: Australian publishers, \$A40.00 (includes GST); overseas publishers, \$A36.00.
7. Copies of nominated books received will become the property of Arts Tasmania and will not be returned to publishers. A copy may be used for marketing purposes by Arts Tasmania.
8. Nominees will be advised of the receipt of their nomination/s.

Judging

1. A panel of three judges, selected by Arts Tasmania, will judge the entries for all three Prizes.
2. All decisions are final and no discussion or correspondence shall be entered into regarding the judging process.

Note: Breach of conditions of entry will render an entry invalid.

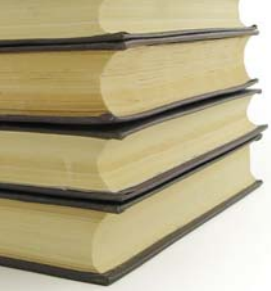
