



Waterside Pavilion, Mawson Place: As available/subject to bookings

Originally a dockside workers complex, the Waterside Pavilion has been reimagined as an attractive, contemporary venue located in the heart of Hobart's waterfront district. The venue has a strong connection to Constitution Dock, natural light, polished hardwood floors and spectacular glulam portal frames. A kitchenette and bathroom facilities are available.

Town Hall, 50 Macquarie Street: As available/subject to bookings

With a grand interior and historically rich venue, Hobart's Town Hall has been hosting events since the late 1860s and has been the scene of many special occasions and events including balls, wedding receptions, public meetings, floral festivals and concerts. With an Ante Room, Auditorium, Meeting Rooms and a hidden, rustic underground, the Town Hall offers an inspiring venue for creative endeavours.

Elizabeth Street Mall, between Collins and Elizabeth Streets: Public space

Located within the CBD, the tree-lined Elizabeth Street Mall was closed off in the 1970s and redeveloped in the late 90s. The venue offers 64m² of sheltered outdoor space with highly prominent foot traffic, provisions for power and a short distance to amenities.

Mathers House, 108 Bathurst Street: Available Monday - Friday 10:00am-2:00pm

Mathers House, originally the Archibald Park Memorial Building, was built by The Council in 1959 as a '60 And Over' Club. Today Mathers House still has a focus on senior members of the community but is a vibrant space open to everyone. The upper floor is a large, bright, open space with kitchen facilities. The lower level is a medium size room with full length mirrors- perfect for dance rehearsals and performances.

Youth Arts + Recreation Centre: Available Monday – Friday 8:30am-5:00pm

Originally part of Hobart's majestic City Hall, this converted warehouse space has been used for a diverse range of tenancies, most notably a drive-through greengrocer! The building now focuses on creative community activities for youth-oriented cultural and creative projects.

Hobart Aquatic Centre, Queens Domain: Available Monday – Friday 8:00am-5:00pm

Formerly the Olympic Pool, the Aquatic Centre sits on the edge of the city and beginning of the bushy Queen's Domain. The light, open interior space reveals this vast location with the backdrop of greenery flooding the trussed curvilinear space.

Gallery Ten, Murray Street

A gallery space inside of the Offices of Ten Days on the Island featuring a large window onto Murray Street, one of Hobart city's major thoroughfares.

Hadley's Orient Hotel, 34 Murray Street

Located in the heart of Hobart's CBD and within walking distance of Salamanca and the waterfront precinct, this National Trust-listed hotel was originally built by convict labour in 1834 and is one of the oldest boutique hotels in Australia.
