While I have written much on the desirability of The Promenade around the foreshore of Battery Point over previous years I understand that the question you ask of me is which of the three types of construction I would prefer so I shall endeavour to keep my response to that and as brief as possible.

on the basis of good taste let alone environmental considerations. I don't know why this question is asked.

*A scramble track along the foreshore is a vote for the *status quo* so that too it out which leaves the - - -

*Raised-on-piers Elevated Boardwalk.

I am in favour of the elevated boardwalk however has any thought been given to a floating

construction such as used in marinas and launch ramps around the waterways of the world and in our region on the Tamar River, Sullivans Cove, The Royal Yacht Club of Hobart. and even at Trial Bay in the Kingborough Municipality.

A floating path-way can be constructed anywhere and floated to the site thus solving the problem of site access and possible damage to property.

At the end of the day I wish to see a walkway around the Battery Point for the enjoyment of all citizens and as a commuting facility for the citizens of all Hobart and the world.
